It is the policy of the Tri-County Regional School Board to support community representation on special or ad hoc committees established for specific purposes that may be of particular importance to a segment of our community.

PROCEDURE Under Policy 101

1. The Tri-County Regional School Board shall either appoint directly or invite nominations for membership to the committee from concerned community groups and/or relevant organizations. If the Board invites nominations, then after the information is received, appointments to the committee shall be made by the School Board.
2. Appointments shall be for a specified period of time.
3. All members of the committee, including community representatives, shall have equal voting privilege.
4. There shall be no remuneration for the services of community representatives, other than travel and out-of-pocket expenses when warranted and approved by the Board Chair.

Note: Special or Ad Hoc committees formed by the School Board have the authority to recommend, but not the authority to make decisions, unless specifically authorized otherwise by the Board.
