It is the policy of the Tri-County Regional Centre for Education to restrict student movement off school grounds after they have arrived each day, where safety and concern might adversely affect the student's well-being.

PROCEDURE under Policy No 708

It shall be the responsibility of the Regional Executive Director to assure that all school principals develop rules and regulations restricting movement of students off school grounds at any time, particularly when students have arrived in the morning and will leave the school at the end of the school day by school board transportation.

It shall be the Principal's discretion to relax this policy and procedures in relation to elementary and junior high town schools where, for the most part, students walk or have personal transportation to school.

Also, in relation to high school students, where age level and maturity are considerations, the Principal may use his/her discretion with regard to students off school grounds.

Students who are 19 years of age and over should be given consideration commensurate with their age and maturity level, as well as for social or personal reasons.

Students at any schools in the Region **shall not be sent off the school grounds** to do errands by any Regional employee.
