**It is the Policy of the Tri-County Regional School Board to be guided by the following procedures with regard to pediculosis (head lice).**

**PROCEDURES** under Policy No **745**

1. The school principal will send out, or make available, Public Health's Treatment Pamphlet How to Prevent, Find and Treat Head Lice to every family at the beginning of each school year and when there is a known occurrence of pediculosis (head lice).
2. School principals will advise the Superintendent of any such occurrence of pediculosis (head lice).
3. At any time pediculosis (head lice) is identified, the parent/guardian will be notified by the school.
4. The affected student shall be excluded from school until all live lice have been removed.
5. Every effort should be made to be discrete and in all cases the student's education shall continue to be a priority, i.e. homework packages provided.
