It is the policy of the Tri-County Regional Centre for Education that the solicitation or the sale of goods and services through the schools will be permitted/endorsed only for the benefit of students.

PROCEDURE Under Policy 302

1. The Regional Executive Director, or designate, hereby delegates the responsibility for the sale of all goods and services through the schools to the Principals.
2. Fundraising and sale of goods must comply with the Food and Nutrition Policy for Nova Scotia Public Schools.
3. Fundraising, school services, and solicitations shall be at the discretion of the Principal, or designate.
4. Students may be exempt from fundraising activities by parent request due to personal beliefs.
 - a. In situations where a student(s) is an active participant in school activities and cannot, due to personal beliefs, partake in fundraising activities, the Regional Centre would encourage that student(s) to explore alternate ways to be an equal contributor to the funding of the activity.
