**It is the policy of the Tri-County Regional Centre for Education to provide a safe and inclusive learning environment for all students, as the Tri-County Regional Centre for Education considers the safety and well-being of students paramount.**

<b>PROCEDURE</b> under Policy No. <b>730</b>
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1. The Tri-County Regional Centre for Education recognizes that victims of mental, physical or sexual assault may be intimidated by the offender attending the same school.
2. The Regional Executive Director of Education or designate may, upon request by a parent of the victim, student or staff, require the offender to be transferred to another school in order to provide a safe learning environment for the victim of the offense. In making this decision, Regional Executive Director of Education or designate shall examine the circumstances of the case, and shall attempt to balance the rights of the victim to a safe learning environment and freedom from intimidation, against the right of the offender to an education in their home school.
