It is the policy of the Tri-County Regional Centre for Education to delegate the responsibility for control of keys to the Principals of the individual buildings (under their jurisdiction).

PROCEDURE Under Policy 527

- 1. The following individuals may have keys to their respective schools:
 - a) Vice Principals
 - b) Custodians
 - c) Supervisor of Property Services
 - d) Tradesperson (for all schools)
 - e) Other persons authorized by the Principal or Coordinator of Property Services
- 2. To ensure proper control of keys, Principals are responsible for keeping accurate and up-to date records of who has keys.
- 3. If keys are lost by Property Services staff, the Property Services Department shall be financially responsible for the replacement of locksets and keys.
- 4. If keys are lost by school staff, the school shall be financially responsible for the replacement of locksets and keys.
