

Social Media Community Guidelines

Tri-County Regional Centre for Education's social media accounts are places for discussing news, events, and stories about our community at TCRCE. We encourage open dialogue, but ask that all comments be respectful and relevant.

Social media accounts will typically respond to enquiries during weekday business hours. Any enquiries during the evenings, weekends, or holidays will be responded to during regular hours. Given that our social media accounts are public, it's best practice to refrain from sharing any personal information.

We reserve the right to remove any comments that we feel are inappropriate or irrelevant. These include, but are not limited to: language, links or content that uses spam, profanity, threats, misinformation or any oppressive/abusive commentary.

Additionally, we will remove any content that is discriminatory, disrespectful or violates an individual's or group's privacy. Some examples of these include comments that are racist, sexist, homophobic, misogynistic, transphobic, or promotes bigotry. Finally, any content that encourages or suggests illegal activity, discusses unproven accusations, or contains sexually explicit or violent imagery will be removed.

We also reserve the right to remove and/or block users who are deemed not to be abiding by the community guidelines. Please note, we are unable to address particulars on social media accounts.
