Art installation in Shelburne will honour firefighters, volunteers, from 2023 wildfire

Production has begun at the Shelburne Regional High School (SRHS) on an art installation that will pay tribute to all of the volunteer firefighting teams, as well as the many volunteers, who helped battle the wildfires in Shelburne County last year, and who helped those impacted by the fires.

The art installation will include 64 hearts with the names of the 64 volunteer fire departments who responded to the Barrington Lake wildfire, along with one big heart to honour all the volunteers who helped behind the front line. The hearts will be placed on the fence in Atlantic Park on Water Street in Shelburne.


